- 3 Key points
 - 1. 56% disagree or strongly disagree: "I am able to use assessments & tasks without modifying."
 - Discussion of the belief that DBL units are required by the district to be implemented.
 - Discussion of the Teacher Bill of Rights and a teachers' degree of autonomy being respected.
 - Discussion of the creation of blended learning lessons as an example of integrated lessons.
 - 2. 38% disagree or strongly disagree: "I am able to deliver a high quality lesson with materials as they are."
 - 3. 34% disagree or strongly disagree: "My curriculum instructional materials are engaging to my students."
 - In summation, these survey questions support the need to be able to modify curricular materials. Some teachers feel that CCTs have mandated the use of DBL.
 - Elementary math teachers would like more assessment & curricular resources created for them.
