 - 2. Discussed headwear and how to word this guideline to allow cultural headwear without allowing offensive or inappropriate items.
 - 3. Agreed to delete "including hair rollers" from the bulleted line about headwear.
 - 4. Discussed including cultural or ethnic headwear as allowable, but all agreed to leave these terms out.
 - 5. The revised statement is: "Headwear is prohibited inside buildings unless within religious or disability guidelines provided it does not obstruct the view of school cameras."
 - 6. Discussed the bulleted statements addressing piercings and tattoos. Agreed to delete the phrase "which distract from the educational process or" from the next to the last bulleted statement in the policy.
