#Students will be recognized as graduating with “state distinction” by attaining a B or better average and completing one of the following(i) attain a score of three (3) or higher on at least two advanced placement exams(ii) earn twelve(12) or more semester hours of transcribed postsecondary credit. Each local school board shall develop a policy prescribing how students graduating with “state distinction” will be noted and recognized.
