The Northwest Viking Battalion has voted on the theme of Paris for our Military Ball in February. This will set the stage for further planning and decoration of our outstanding military ball.



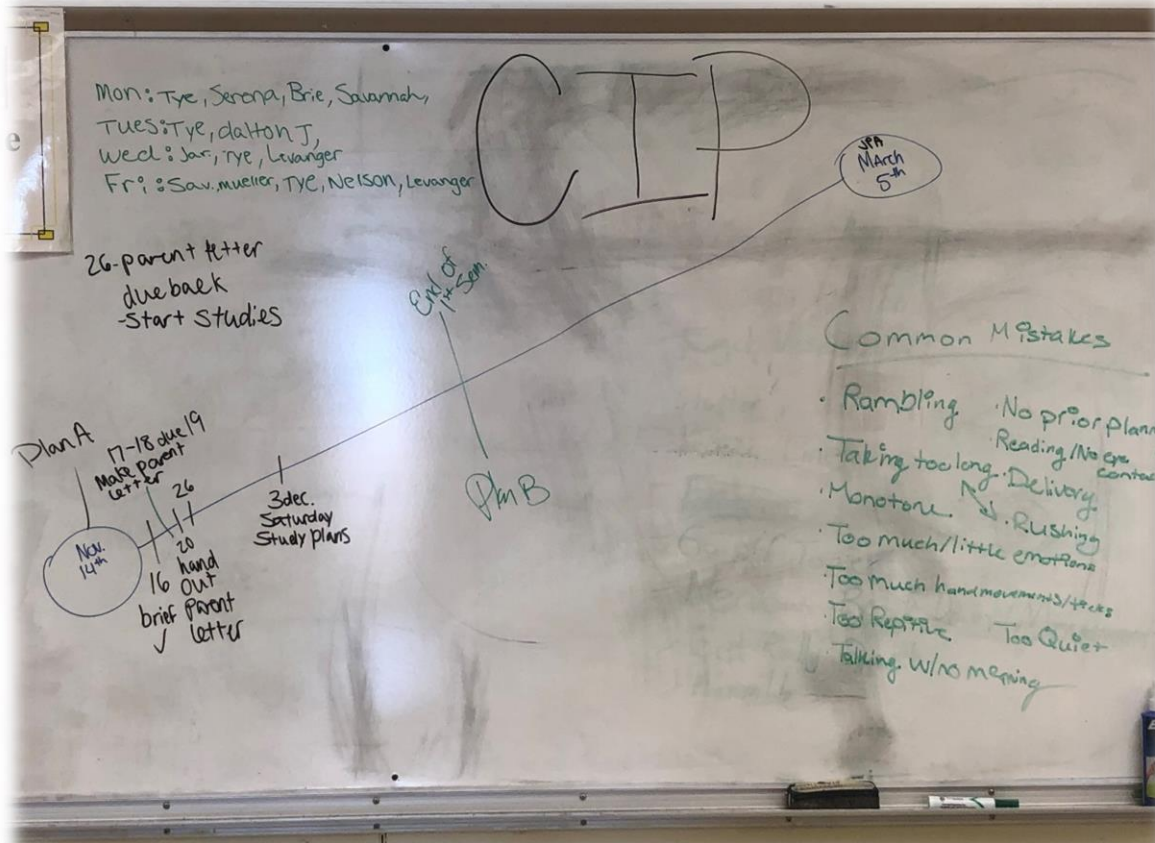
