Annually, the West Creek High School JROTC program travels to the Fort Donelson National Battlefield in Dover, TN to get a history lesson and to have a first-hand experience of extremities the Union and Confederate soldiers had to undergo while fighting for their half of the country. Cadets in LET levels ranging from 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> are picked to attend this trip; LET 4s are broken into different groups and are assigned one stop out of 11 to research and present to the rest of the cadets attending.
