History Field Trip

WHEN: 25 October 2019

WHERE: Fort Donelson National Battlefield, Dover, Tennessee

WHY: To provide reinforcing exposure to U.S. History, Leadership, Decision Making and Physical Fitness.

OUTCOMES: Cadets applied the values of American Heritage and History, Teamwork, Fitness Student Achievement and Character during this event.



SUMMARY: On the 25th of October 2019, 74 CMCSS JROTC Cadets, their Instructors, representatives of the CMCSS DAI Office and guest historians from Austin Peay State University, traveled to Dover, Tennessee to tour the Fort Donelson National Battlefield site. This event was researched, coordinated and led by the Rossview High School JROTC S-7, c/CPT Chyna Hogan. Cadets, with the support of Dr. Michele Butts and Dr. Timothy Wesley, Briefed all in attendance about this historic battle, what led up to it and its impact on the Civil War and our Nations History. Cadets also received an informative briefing from Dr. Butts on the disposition of Prisoners of War (POW's) upon their return to the CMCSS Central Services – South Educational Campus.
