


UNITED STATES ARMY CADET COMMAND

SUMMARY: As part of their APSU/RHS Dual Enrollment Course "Leadership in Emergency Response II", the cadets completed Unit 2: Fire Safety and Utility Controls. The culminating event for the unit was a hands-on fire extinguisher lesson using the Bullseye[™] Digital Fire Extinguisher Training System that was provided by the Montgomery County Emergency Management Office..
