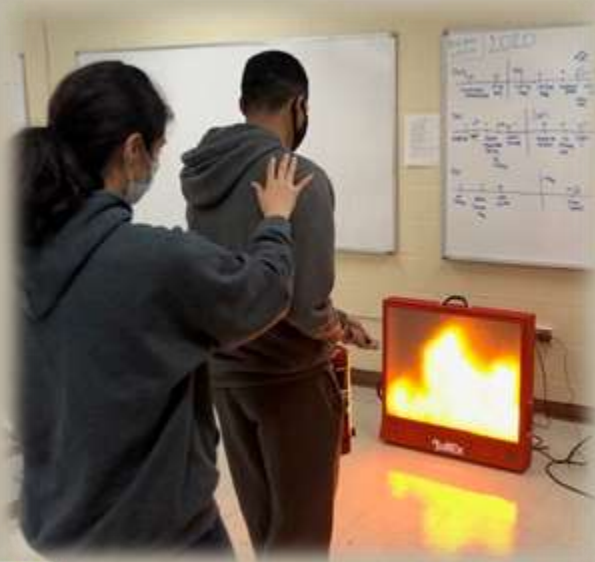
**WHO:** NWHS JROTC LET IVs
