SUMMARY: To assist the Mount Olive Historical Preservation Society, RHS JROTC Cadets volunteered as part of the Mount Olive Cemetery Clean-Up to honor the Veterans buried there. Cadets assisted in the cleaning of headstones, upgraded of trails, clearing of brush, trees and debris and emplaced mulch in the flower beds. In November of 2020, Mount Olive Cemetery was added to the National Register of Historic Places. Mount Olive was established in 1817 and is Clarksville Tennessee's largest, private African American cemetery, which accepted interments from 1817-1958.
