WHAT: SY 22-23 All Service and All Army Drill and Fitness Competitions, Point of Pride Color Guard Recognition Ceremony, and posting of the colors at the MCHS Graduation
WHEN: May 3-8, May 16th, May 26th
WHERE: Ocean Center, Daytona Beach, FL, CMCSS Building, Clarksville, TN, MCHS, Cunningham, TN, APSU, Clarksville, TN
WHY: To compete at a national level after a full year of dedication and competition, to recognize the MCHS Drill Teams 1st place Division 3 National Champion Demilitarized Color Guard and the 3rd place Division 3 National level Alternative Color Guard, and to Post the Colors at the MCHS Graduation..

OUTCOMES: The Indian Battalion took the month of May to compete at the national level in Division 3 bringing home 1st in Demilitarized Color Guard and 3rd Overall Unarmed, recognizing the color guards as they placed 1st in demilitarized and 3rd place Alternative, and the posting of the Colors at the MCHS graduation.
