All RHS JROTC cadets participate in the annual cadet challenge as part of the Battalions Continuous Improvement Plan. The cadet challenge consists of 1-mile run, shuttle run, sit & reach, curl-ups, and pull-ups. Cadets use the results to reveal what they need to improve on throughout the school year. The Record Assessment resulted in the following awards: Presidential – 7, National – 15, Pull-Up Ribbons – 23, 1-Mile Run Ribbons – 9 and Cadet Challenge Arcs - 2.
