SUMMARY: Before Family, friends and Faculty, c/LTC Layla Starmack and c/CPT Erin Starmack were awarded the Department of the Army Medal of Heroism by CSM Eric Hayes, 7th Brigade Command Sergeant Major, in a ceremony at Rossview High School. The sisters responded to an emergency at their home when their father was severely injured. Working as a team, the cadets provided medical treatment which resulted in the application of a tourniquet. The rapid and accurate actions of the cadets were a result of their "Stop the Bleed" medical training, and training received as members of the JROTC and the Girl Scouts, and saved their father's life.
