## Dr. Angela Huff provided a Director's Update

- On February 22, the Board will vote on a proposed zoning recommendation from the Zoning Committee. That recommendation included a phased-in approach that will allow families to keep students enrolled in their current schools, as long as they provide their own transportation.
- There were no further questions about the rezoning recommendation at this point.

## Dr. Kimmie Sucharski, Director of Accountability, provided an update on AMO Targets

- The state provided a "hold harmless" provision to districts as part of legislation passed during a special session in January 2021.
- Due to this hold harmless provision, the Tennessee Department of Education used data from the 2018-2019 TCAP assessments to set performance goals for districts in the 2021-2022 school year, known as Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs).
- This decision to use 2018-2019 data resulted in AMO targets that were unrealistic, and several districts expressed a desire to ensure that 2020-2021 data were used to set those goals.
- The legislature is hearing a bill that would allow for this change.

- Recently, CMCSS partnered with the Tennessee Department of Education to establish the nation's first Teacher Apprenticeship Pathway recognized by the Department of Labor.
