



Coordinated School Health Screening Information
Please read the following letter in regards to student screenings.

Dear Parent or Guardian,

In accordance with Tennessee law 49-6-1022, TN school systems are required to implement a Coordinated School Health (CSH) program throughout the school year. Furthermore, to maintain compliance with the state law, the CSH program will require the collection of health-related data from CMCSS students as per TN 49-6-1401 and TN 49-6-1402.

However, due to COVID-19 screenings are not required for the 2020-2021 school year.

CMCSS will provide *free* Wellness Screenings (hearing, vision, blood pressure, height, weight, pacer, color deficiency and BMI) to students present in the traditional setting in grades Pre-K, K, 2, 4, 6, 8 and 9 (please see below) as able. Trained personnel will complete all screenings with strict adherence to the confidentiality of each child and this data will be provided anonymously to the state for the purpose of data collection. No identifying information will be provided to the state (e.g. names, student identification number, etc.).
