



Out-of-zone Independent Study for Academy Students Clarksville-Montgomery County Schools

Due to the timing of bus transportation for students attending out of zone Academies, students riding the bus back to their zoned school cannot attend a full 7th period class.

As a result, students utilizing out-of-zone bus transportation have the option to complete one online course per year.

- The student must have computer and Internet access outside of the school day, as the course will be completed online.
- Students will work through the course material independently. The first semester of the course must be completed by December 14, 2017. The second semester of the course must be completed by May 18, 2018.
- Grades for the course will be entered on student transcripts and will be calculated into student GPAs.
- Failure to complete the course once begun will be noted as an incomplete on student transcripts.

Students who opt not to take an online course will need to work closely with the school counselor to ensure all graduation credit requirements are met within the six periods they are in school each day.

As a student entering an Academy utilizing out-of-zone bus transportation, one of the following choices must be made:

What transportation options are available if a student chooses an academy not offered at his/her zoned school?

Parents are responsible for transportation to the Academy if it is located outside of the student's zoned school. In an effort to provide limited, sustainable transportation options, we have established bus transportation partnerships as follows: students may travel between KHS and WCHS, MCHS and CHS, NEHS and RHS, NWHS and WCHS, and NWHS and KHS. Bus routes will be discontinued at the end of the 2018-2019 school year between NWHS and WCHS.

Students ride their assigned bus to their zoned middle school. Next they ride a second bus from the zoned middle school to the Academy at the partnered school. In the afternoon, students leave the Academy school during 7th period to return to zoned high school in order to catch their assigned bus home. All bus routes will be confirmed prior to the start of the student's school year.
