ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS

The online version of this policy is official. Therefore, all printed versions of this document are unofficial copies.

The constitutional by-laws of the Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association (TSSAA) shall be observed and considered as the minimum rules, regulations and standards governing interscholastic athletic programs, including dance and cheerleading, in the Clarksville-Montgomery County School System (CMCSS). Additionally, all CMCSS interscholastic athletics programs shall adhere to the procedures and guidance promulgated by the Safety and Health Director and District Programs and Activities Coordinator in the Coaches Handbook (RSK-M004).

The Principal or designee is responsible for the administration and control of athletic programs within his or her school. All CMCSS employees involved in the operation of interscholastic athletics, including but not limited to principals, athletic directors, coaches and assistant coaches, are responsible for reviewing on an annual basis and complying with the constitutional by-laws of the TSSAA and the policies and procedures set forth in the Coaches Handbook (RSK-M004).
