INTERNET SAFETY and TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION

It is the policy of Clarksville-Montgomery County School System to educate students and staff about Internet safety. The education provided will be designed to promote the district's commitment to standards and acceptable use of CMCSS technology and network set forth in the district's Technology Acceptable Use policy (TCH-A002) and compliance with E-rate requirements of the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) including:

- a) access by minors to inappropriate matter on the Internet;
- b) the safety and security of minors when using electronic mail, chat rooms, and other forms of direct electronic communications;
- c) unauthorized access, including so-called "hacking," and other unlawful activities by minors online;
- d) unauthorized disclosure, use, and dissemination of personal information regarding minors; and
- e) measures restricting minors' access to materials harmful to them.
