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THREAT ASSESSMENT TEAMS

A threat assessment team shall be created within the school district to develop intervention-based approaches to prevent violence, manage reports of potential threats, and create a system that fosters a safe, supportive, and effective school environment.

The school teams will be made up of the principal, assistant principal, school counselor/social worker/ mental health staff, SRO, etc.

The team shall document all behaviors and incidents deemed to pose a risk to school safety or that resulted in intervention.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-2701, threat assessment team meetings shall be closed to the public, and all documents produced or obtained regarding these assessment activities will remain confidential and will not be open for public inspection.
