- Restorative activity, empathy, mediation, etc.



Transient

SOC* does not pose a threat, at this time



• Gather data



- Conference with **SOC***, Parent/Guardian, School Threat Assessment Team
- Develop Support Plan with SOC*, Parent/Guardian, TA Team
- Plans for re-entry to school, classroom, or other setting
- Release of Confidentiality for Mental Health supports
- Notification of "need to know" personnel
- **SOC***monitoring/assignment of case manager/mentor
- Documentation of ALL statements, evidentiary supports, and Threat Assessment documents.





SOC*may pose a threat



Ongoing

- revise support plan/ interventions, as needed
- provide transition school information to "need to know staff"
