

FIRE ALARM ACTIVATION PROCEDURE (SAF-P014)

1.0 SCOPE:

1.1 Pursuant to T.C.A. §49-6-807(e), in the event of a fire alarm activation this procedure outlines a response protocol in determining the cause.

5.0 PROCEDURE:

- 5.1 This procedure applies to all CMCSS employees, students, volunteers, and visitors who occupy a CMCSS building during a fire alarm activation.
- 5.2 In the event of a fire alarm activation, all building occupants should assess their immediate environment and select the safest response, in accordance with the District's Standard Response Protocol.
- 5.3 Items below should be considered when determining the best course of action:
 - What is the immediate threat?
 - Do you see fire?
 - Do you see or smell smoke?
 - Do you hear gunshots?
 - Is there an active threat between the class and the path of evacuation?
