## HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Clarksville-Montgomery County School System provides homebound instruction to any child with a health, emotional, and/or physical impairment which, in the opinion of a licensed medical examiner, causes him/her to be absent from school for more than two consecutive weeks and would benefit educationally from such a program.

The amount of instructional or supportive services provided through the home and hospital program will be determined in relation to each child's educational needs and his/her physical and mental health.
