



Parent Contract for Homebound Services (STS-F006)

Your child, _____, has been assigned homebound services as of _____ until _____. The Homebound Teacher will meet with your child on _____ (days) at _____ (time). The return date to school is _____.

This program is designed for students who are unable to attend regular school for 10 school days up to a maximum of 30 school days due to a temporary health impairment. The goal is to return to the regular school setting as soon as possible.

The Homebound Teacher receives assignments from the regular classroom teacher(s). Instruction will be a minimum of three (3) hours per week (2 sessions of 1.5 hours each).

The success of the instruction and progress of your child depend upon cooperative planning with the home, the child, and the teacher. Please sign below to agree to the following conditions:

- A. If you have a question concerning your child's homebound services, please call 542-5069 (Director of Student Services) or 542-5068 (Student Services Manager).
- B. Provide a suitable place where teacher and student can work without being disturbed (free of noise, smoke, and pets). In an effort to transition students back to the regular school setting, students who are on homebound for emotional/mental health reasons will receive homebound instruction in the Student Services Department at the Greenwood Complex.
- C. The student will be ready with charged computer, books, completed assignments, paper, and pencils at the scheduled time.
- D. A parent / guardian or other adult (18 years or older) must be present in the home during the homebound instructional time. Names should be listed on the homebound form.
- E. If the student is unable to have instruction at the scheduled time, the parent should as soon as possible:
 - 1. Notify the Homebound Teacher _____ (office phone). AND
 - 2. Notify the Student Services department at 542-5068 or 542-5069.*Cancellations will not be accepted from the student.
- F. Students who are not completing work or cancel 3 times without adequate, excused absences (DR notes) could be terminated from homebound and referred back to their home school. A truancy petition could be filed with juvenile court.
- G. Help the student establish a routine for study between the teacher's visits. The student should work a minimum of 4 hours per school day on schoolwork.
- H. If a student needs an extension of homebound services, a NEW parent request for homebound services must be completed within two weeks in advance of the ending date.
- I. Students are NOT allowed to work outside the home or play sports while receiving homebound services.
