STUDENT VANDALISM OF SCHOOL BUSES POLICY

Unnecessary and wanton abuse of a school bus by a student will result in that student being ineligible for transportation in addition to any other disciplinary measures. Student will become eligible again when payment is made for damage and assurance given that the abuse will not reoccur.

The following will be followed when damage is done to a bus:

First Offense: Any student caught cutting, tearing, or defacing a bus seat in any manner or damaging a school bus in any other manner will be suspended from riding any bus in the Clarksville-Montgomery County School System until restitution is made by student, parents/guardian.

Second Offense: Any student caught cutting, tearing, or defacing a bus seat or damaging a school bus in any other manner the second time must pay for the restitution and will be suspended from the bus for the remainder of the school year. If the offense occurs during the second semester of the school year, the suspension will carry over to the first semester of the next school year.

Third Offense: Any student caught cutting, tearing, or defacing a bus seat or damaging a school bus in any other manner the third time must pay for the restitution and will be suspended from riding a school bus for the remainder of his/her school career.
