

Student Medical Emergency While on a School Bus TRN-W005



DESCRIPTION: This instruction outlines the process for addressing a student with an illness or injury on a school bus.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTION:


- The school bus driver will immediately contact Base 1 upon discovering a student with an illness
 or injury requiring medical assistance. The driver will provide their location and a brief description
 of the emergency.
- 2. Base 1 will immediately call 911 and request an ambulance.
- 3. Base 1 will contact the bus driver via radio and ask the student's name and school.
- 4. Base 1 will then log into PowerSchool to view the student's medical history. Do not communicate student medical information over the radio network.
- If the student has any medical conditions (Diabetes, Asthma, Seizure Disorder, etc.), Base 1 will call 911 back and update the 911 dispatcher with this information and ask the 911 dispatcher to notify the responding paramedics.
