FORKS AND MAST - not bent, worn, or 2 cracked. LOAD BACK REST EXTENSION - in place 3 and not bent, cracked, or loose. FORKLIFT BODY - free of excessive grease OVERHEAD GUARD - not bent, worn, or 5 cracked. BATTERY CONNECTIONS - tight. COVERS - in place and secure. LOAD RATING PLATE - present and readable. WARNING DECALS & OPERATOR 9 MANUAL - present and readable. MIRRORS (if equipped) - correctly adjusted 10 and are not damaged. SEAT BELT/RESTRAINT - accessible and 11 not damaged, oily, or dirty. ENGINE - runs smooth and quiet, without 12 leaks or sparks from the exhaust. HORN - operational. LIGHTS (head, tail, and warning) - work and are aimed correctly. GAUGES & INSTRUMENTS - work 15 properly. CONTROL LEVERS - labeled, not loose or 16 binding, freely return to neutral. STEERING - smooth and responsive, free of 17 excessive play. BRAKES - work and function smoothly, 18 without grabbing.

BACKUP ALARM (if equipped) - works.

FUEL LEVEL - okay and free of leaks.
